The Company

Formosa Plastics Corporation, U.S.A.

was founded in the United States in 1978 and is a growing supplier of plastic resins and related petrochemicals. With over 2,100 full-time employees and annual sales exceeding \$4 billion, we are now one of the nation's largest plastic resins producers.



Formosa is a privately held, de-centralized company based in New Jersey with manufacturing facilities in Delaware, Louisiana and Texas. We operate through six business divisions – Oil and Gas, Olefins, Polyolefins, Chlor-Alkali, Vinyl and Specialty Polyvinyl Chloride.

We are making significant new capital investments in our U.S. operations, including our manufacturing plants and oil/gas exploration. Subsidiary companies include Neumin Production Company (oil/gas exploration



and production), Lavaca Pipe Line Company (natural gas transmission) and Formosa Hydrocarbons Company (natural gas processing).

We make many of the plastics that go into products that people use daily – like food storage and garbage bags, beverage containers and caps, automotive panels, home siding, water and wastewater pipe, floor tiles, windows, doors, appliances, decks, decorative fences and more.



Formosa Plastics Corporation, U.S.A. is affiliated with the Formosa Plastics Group (FPG), a global leader in petrochemicals, plastics, electronics and many other industries. Worldwide, FPG has over 95,000 employees and annual sales of more than \$60 billion.

Texas

Our Texas site operates as Formosa Plastics Corporation, Texas in Point Comfort, about three hours southwest of Houston. The main site covers 1,600 acres, has 1,800 full-time employees and contributes nearly \$300 million annually to the local economy in salaries, services and taxes.



Fifteen operating units produce a variety of intermediate raw materials and final products, including:

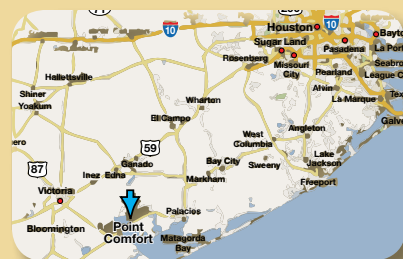
Infrastructure facilities include:

Employees are active in their communities. They volunteer in local government, churches, schools, hospitals, and build Habitat for Humanity homes. The site has helped purchase local fire response equipment and school buses.

Louisiana

Baton Rouge is home to our manufacturing site in Louisiana; it operates as Formosa Plastics Corporation, Louisiana. The site is located on the north side of the city along the east bank of the Mississippi River.



The site's 220 employees produce intermediate raw materials such as vinyl chloride monomer and finished suspension PVC resin, which is shipped worldwide.



Infrastructure facilities include:

- Steam/electricity generation,
- Quality assurance laboratories,
- Marine terminal,
- Rail loading/unloading, and
- Wastewater treatment.

The site participates in the U.S. EPA's ENERGY STAR® Partnership and further committed to the ENERGY STAR® Challenge to improve the site's energy efficiency by at least 10%.



The site continues to set safety records. In 2006 it had no recordable injuries – zero. In 2009 it achieved the safety milestone of 2,000,000 man-hours without a reportable injury. Not satisfied with near-perfection, it has begun a behavioral-based safety program to increase employees' ability to help each other be even safer.

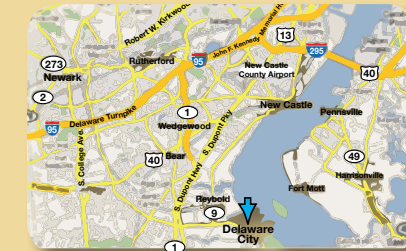
The Baton Rouge site has hosted more than six Habitat for Humanity builds, conducts monthly blood drives and sponsors a local Junior Achievement chapter.

Site employees are active in a variety of community support activities and programs, public service, and scientific education initiatives.



Delaware

Formosa's site in Delaware City, Delaware produces specialty (dispersion) polyvinyl chloride used in hygienic gloves, fabric coatings, automotive parts and traffic safety cones. It is 'backward integrated' through its use of raw materials produced by our Texas & Louisiana sites and operates as Formosa Plastics Corporation, Delaware.



The site's 101 employees take great pride in their craft, producing products that improve peoples' lives and health. They're active in the community, supporting the Delaware Nature Society, the Delaware City Canal Fest (environmental celebration) and many other local charities.

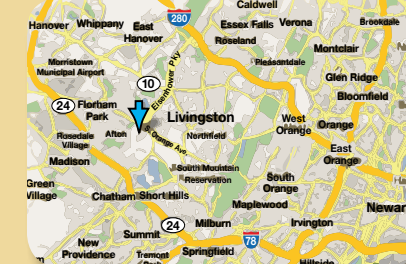
New Jersey

Our corporate headquarters is located in Livingston, New Jersey, where 260 full-time employees provide the majority of our business support operations. These include business management, marketing and sales, legal, logistics, technology development, accounting, human resources, information technology, environment, safety and corporate communications.



As at Formosa's other locations, our employees are active in local government, charitable groups, fine arts, scouting and church activities. This past year, our annual food drive provided over 6,700 pounds of food and 400 turkeys to needy families in the area.

We also hold annual blood drives, participate in company Habitat for Humanity building projects and support local community services.
