Dear Valued Customer,

Formosa Plastics Corporation, U.S.A. ("Formosa") is dedicated to protecting the environment in the communities where our customers and employees work and live. As part of its efforts, Formosa has committed to a goal of zero plastic pellet, flake, and powder loss into the environment as part of Operation Clean Sweep® and through Formosa's own sustainability efforts. Additionally, Formosa continues to work to improve containment measures at its operating sites in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, and Point Comfort, Texas.

As a Formosa customer, you are an important part of Formosa's sustainability efforts. Formosa asks that you join in its efforts and adopt Operation Clean Sweep® (OCS) practices to assist in preventing plastic powders and pellets from being improperly spilled into the environment. OCS practices include employee training, implementation of engineering controls, and cleanup of any pellet or powder spills.

A key part of Formosa's sustainability efforts is preventing pellet and powder loss in loading and unloading of railcars. Formosa monitors railcars that are returned by customers with open or missing hatches, gates, or caps, which allow pellet or powder spills from railcars during their return trip to Formosa facilities. In addition to negative impacts on the environment, railcars returned with open or improperly sealed hatches, gates, and outlet caps violate Formosa's General Terms and Conditions of Sale.
